Request for Proposals (RFP) Engineering, Environmental Review and Planning Services for SB2 and LEAP Implementation

The City of Arvin (City) requests sealed proposal for services associated with the implementation of the California Housing and Community Development department's priorities to streamline and accelerate housing production in the state to include projects regarding, but not limited to, accessory dwelling units, updating zoning standards, and environmental analyses and studies for possible high-density residential sites.

The scope of this proposal will be to assist the City of Arvin in all, aspects of these projects, including but not limited to the development of an ADU Ordinance and City ADU Program to include a processing guide, internal policy and procedure, and pre-approved design plans; Updating and Amending the City's Title 17 Zoning Code to include but not limited to, illustrative drawings and procedural services; and environmental analyses for up to three potential high-density residential project sites.
